

The Ultimate PoGo Spoofing Guide

Location Spoofing - The Basics

What this section covers

How to teleport to a new location using Go Fly Vietnam, confirm it on the map, use the joystick overlay in-game, and stop spoofing when finished. This app comes pre-loaded with 52 routes, so you can either jump straight to popular spots or set your own custom coordinates.

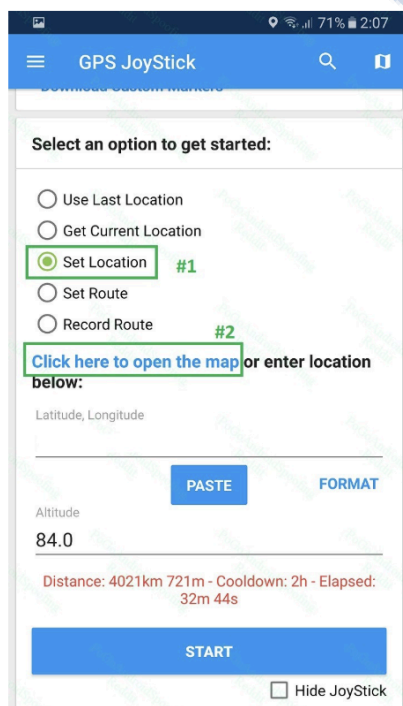
Risk notice

Spoofing violates Pokémon Go terms of service. Niantic may issue warnings, soft bans, or permanent account bans. This guide explains how the app works. Use it at your own risk. Spoofing on a rooted device is safer though of course, especially if you follow cooldown rules.

Step-by-step: teleport method:

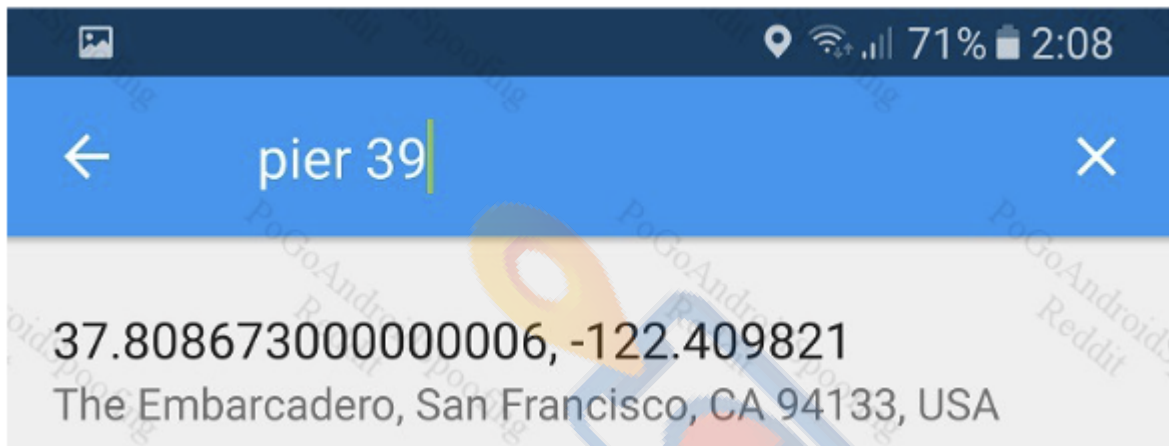
Open Go Fly Vietnam and choose Set Location

Tap Set Location from the main menu.



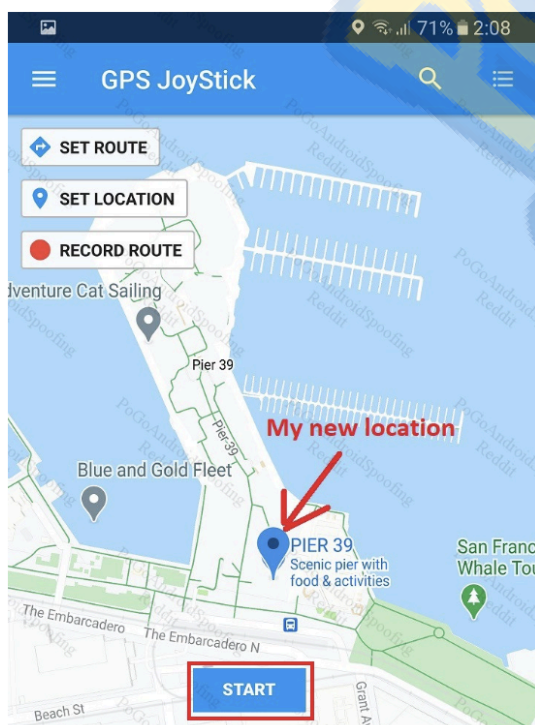
Paste and format coordinates

Paste your chosen coordinates into the box. If they include extra text (like “coords:” before the numbers), press FORMAT so only the numbers remain. Set altitude to 0 if you don’t know it.



Confirm on the map

Tap Click here to open the map. Search for your destination (e.g., Pier 39 in San Francisco) or tap the pin directly. Press START to apply the location.



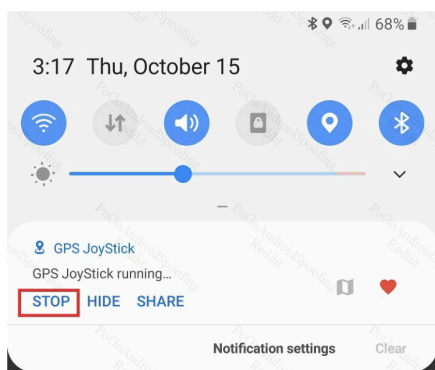
Switch to Pokémon Go

Once START is pressed, open the game. The joystick overlay will appear. Use it to nudge your trainer's movement or lock it for straight auto-walk.



Stop spoofing

When you're done, pull down the notification bar and press STOP from the Go Fly Vietnam notification.



Using the 52 pre-installed routes

Go Fly Vietnam has **52 built-in GPX routes**. These are ready-to-use walking paths through popular areas like big cities, hotspots, and event zones.

- Open the **Route menu** from the main app screen.
- Select a route from the list.
- Press **Play** to auto-walk the full route, or **Pause/Resume** as needed.
- You can also load your own custom GPX files later if you want more control.

Pro tips

- Use **pre-installed routes** to blend movement with more realism instead of teleporting everywhere.
- Save your favorite teleport locations in the app if you revisit them often.
- Always press **STOP** when you're finished to avoid issues with your phone's GPS.

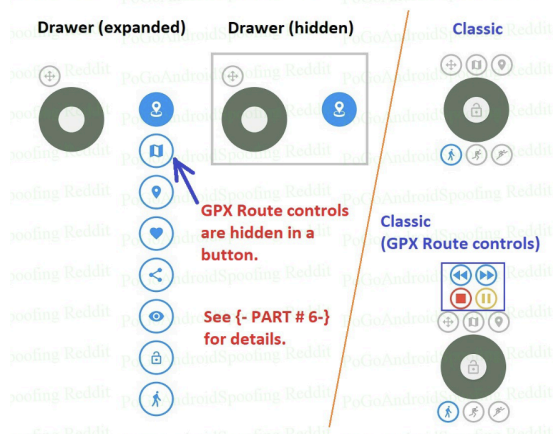
GPS Joystick Buttons and Controls Guide

Classic vs Drawer Mode



There are two control styles: **Classic** and **Drawer**.

- **Classic mode** keeps the screen cleaner, showing only the joystick and hiding most buttons in a dropdown menu.
- **Drawer mode** displays all buttons alongside the joystick for quick access.

Both modes have the same functions – the only difference is how they look and where the buttons are placed. It's purely personal preference.

#1. Niantic's Anti-Cheat is real – you take the risk

If you break Niantic's Terms of Service and get a strike or ban, that is on you. I am not responsible or liable for any loss of Niantic accounts. #2. Critical stuff to know before using Pokemod

1. Pokemod is an unauthorized third-party app

Pokemod is not approved by Niantic and does not claim to be "safe." Using it breaks the game's Terms of Service and exposes you to Niantic's strike system. Anyone who tells you an unauthorized app is 100% safe is lying.

2. Combining tools: Pokemod + PGSharp (No Root)

Some players run Pokemod together with PGSharp No Root to get features from both. That's how I run my setup because Pokemod gives useful overlays while PGSharp offers a customizable feed and auto-attack with dodge for raids and gyms. Expect tradeoffs: each tool adds risk and different features.

3. You can reduce risk by playing like a legit player

You may lower your chance of being detected by behaving more like a normal player. Follow cooldowns, avoid unrealistic teleport patterns, use walk mode or prebuilt routes, and keep speeds conservative. Quick how to play (what you actually do)

1. Set your fake location first using your joystick app, or make sure your location is already set in PGSharp.

2. Open Pokemod and tap **START SERVICE**.
3. The game will automatically load with the mods active.
4. Play. Keep movement and interactions humanlike, follow cooldowns, and stop the service when you finish.

PGSharp Launcher (modified joystick app) for Android 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14:

Starting up PGSharp

1. Open the **PGS Root** app.
2. Tap **ENABLE** (if it isn't already enabled).
3. Tap **START**.
4. Pokémon Go will launch with a **Yellow Star** icon in the top-left corner.

If the Yellow Star does not appear, it means PGSharp didn't inject properly. Close the game and repeat Step 3.

Starting location

- By default, you begin at a popular spoofing hotspot in **New York City, USA**.
 - Before logging in, decide where you actually want to play. This matters because of Niantic's anti-cheat system. Many players say "I only spoof locally" but still get strikes — often because they didn't respect cooldowns.
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Cooldown reminder

- If you switch areas (e.g., from your home country to New York), you need to wait a **cooldown of 8–24 hours** before logging in.
 - During cooldown, do not open the game.
 - Example: If you last played in London and want to spoof to NYC, you must wait the cooldown first to reduce strike risk.
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Changing your location before login

1. Tap the **Yellow Star**.
 2. Tap the **Map icon** (below the Star, above the Bike icon).
 3. Tap the **Search icon** (top-left corner).
 4. Enter an address or city/country.
 5. Select the location from search results.
 6. A blue pin will appear on the map with coordinates.
 7. Tap **Teleport** to lock your GPS to that spot in PGSharp.
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Logging in

5. Tap **Returning Player** to sign in.
 6. Allow Pokémon Go to **access your device's GPS/location** (must be enabled).
 7. Allow Pokémon Go to **take pictures and record video** (also must be enabled).
 8. Accept the **Privacy Policy pop-up** — this is Niantic's standard notice about their Social app and data collection.
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Game settings tip

- Go into **Settings > Game Logs** and **uncheck "Save Raid and Battle Logs."**
 - Leaving this enabled can use 2 GB per log, adding up to 3–4 GB of wasted space.
 - Turning it off also avoids extra background logging.
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Quick session guide (PGSharp Launcher)

- Open **PGS Root** app.
- Tap **ENABLE** if not already active.
- Tap **START**.

- Pokémon Go opens at your last spoofed location.

👉 If you want to start somewhere else each time, log out after every session. That way, you can set a new location before logging in again.

PGTools bots: PaC (Auto Catcher), PaH (Auto Hatch), PaG (Auto Team Rocket Grunt, PaS (Auto Sundo) and GPS Joystick Wrapper for for Android 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, or 14:

Free premium trials

PGTools sometimes offers free premium access during special events. This is a good chance to test the app and decide if you want to invest in the paid version.

In-game limits you need to know

Encounters & catches

- Daily limit: **4,800 Pokémon**
- Weekly limit: **14,000 Pokémon**

“Encounter” = tapping a Pokémon to check/catch.

“Catch” = successfully throwing a Pokéball and capturing.

⚠ These limits apply to **PaC (auto catcher)** for wild and quest Pokémon.

PaG (Team Rocket bot) does not appear to have these limits, based on their Discord.

Pro tip: Stay below the hard cap. Aim for **4,000–4,400 daily** instead of maxing out at 4,799, since fleeing Pokémon still count toward the limit.

Punishment for exceeding:

- “BSOD” (Blue Screen of Death / suspicious activity screen). You’ll be locked out for **24 hours**.
 - Repeated violations may escalate to Niantic’s **3-strike system**. Niantic has been known to skip directly to a **30-day ban** or even a **permanent ban**.
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PokéStop spins

- Daily limit: **1,200 spins**
- Weekly limit: **7,000 spins**

Punishment for exceeding:

- You'll see an error message: *"Try again later"*. No more items can be collected until the counter resets.
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Botting risks

Because PGTools includes automated features, Niantic may treat it as more severe than standard spoofing. This can lead to punishments like:

- **Red-slashed Pokémon:** These can only be transferred. They cannot be used in raids, gyms, trades, or battles. A red line appears across the Pokémon sprite.
 - This was last widely seen in the **November 2019 ban wave**, but Niantic could reintroduce it.
 - Remember: Niantic can skip straight to a **permanent ban** (3rd strike) if they choose.

Key features include:

- **PaC (Auto Catcher)** – has a free version; premium adds advanced functions.
- **PaH (Auto Hatch)** – automates egg hatching.
- **PaG (Auto Team Rocket Grunt)** – automates grunt battles.

- **PaS (Auto Shundo)** – helps identify shundos.

Pokemod Options

Pokemod offers four different tools, each designed for different levels of spoofing and automation:

- **Enhancer**

A modified joystick app with extra features, free to use. Best if you want manual control with added quality-of-life improvements.

- **Farmer**

A bot that plays the game for you once you configure it. Handles encounters, spins, and farming tasks automatically.

- **Premium Farmer**

An advanced version of the Farmer bot with more power and more automation. It costs more but can perform functions well beyond what PGTools or Shungo offer.

- **FlyMeGo**

A lighter, simpler bot alternative to Shungo. Easier to set up, focused on automated play without as many configuration steps.

Pricing & free trial

Shungo is a **paid app** with a limited free trial.

- Free trial: up to **3 Shundos**.
 - Subscription: **€14.99 per month**.
 - Purchase: shungo.app → log in with your Shungo account → click **Buy Now** → pay via Stripe (Debit/Credit) or PayPal.
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In-game limits

Encounters

- Definition: Tapping a Pokémon to check for shiny or to attempt a catch (including flees).
- Limit: **7,000–10,000 per day** (Shungo recommends **5,000**).
- Note: This number is Shungo-specific and does not account for “shiny scanner” usage in other apps (Pokemod, iPogo, PGSharp, Polygon). With scanners, there's no way to track total encounters.

Catches

- Daily limit: **4,800 Pokémon**
- Weekly limit: **14,000 Pokémon**

Punishment if exceeded:

- **BSOD (Blue Screen of Death / suspicious activity screen)** → locked out for 24 hours.

- Repeated triggers may escalate to strikes. Niantic can skip directly to a 30-day ban or permanent ban.

PokéStop spins

- Daily limit: **1,200 spins**
- Weekly limit: **7,000 spins**

Punishment if exceeded:

- You'll see *"Try again later"* when spinning. No more items will be granted until the counter resets.

Botting risk

Because Shungo automates gameplay, Niantic may punish more severely:

- **Red-slashed Pokémon** → only transferable, cannot be traded or used in raids, gyms, or battles.
 - This punishment last appeared in the **November 2019 ban wave**, but Niantic could bring it back.
 - Niantic may also skip directly to a permanent ban (3rd strike).

Setup (basic flow)

1. Set your location in your joystick app.
2. Open the **Shungo** app.
3. Tap **GRANT** to allow SuperUser access.
4. Tap **Login** and enter your Shungo account details.
 - If new, press **Sign Up** and create an account with username, email, and password.
5. Once logged in, configure your settings.

6. Under **Other**, enable **BSOD Prevention** to stay under the 4,800 encounter/catch limit.
 7. Press **Save Settings**.
 8. Tap **Start** to launch the game with Shungo enabled.
 9. When finished, close Pokémon Go and press **Stop** in Shungo.
